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# 1

### Summary

- A. Period of Study: 6 months or 1 year
- B. Academic Courses (CBNU)
  - 1) Undergraduate
  - 2) Graduate: Applicants who are in graduate degrees MUST be nominated by a professor who is doing a collaborative research with CBNU professor
  - \* Mandatory to submit a Recommendation Letter written by a collaborator from applicant's university

#### C. Classes

- 1) Liberal arts · Major subjects
  - It requires a certain level of proficiency in Korean or English (for English classes)
- 2) Korean Classes for International Students
  - Available only to undergraduate students
  - Students will not be able to enroll in classes if the classes are full.
- 3) Others
  - Both undergraduates and graduate students can pay extra fees for taking additional Korean classes.

## 2

### Application

- A. Deadline for Online Application: 30 June, 2019(Sunday)
  - Complete the Application Form and upload the required documents through the URL https://all.jbnu.ac.kr/jbnu/oasis/online\_application.html

#### <Note>

- 1. Any fraudulent or misleading information found on your application and supporting documents will result in cancellation of admission. (Applicants will take full responsibility for any consequences caused by false information.)
- 2. Name on your application MUST match the name in your passport.
- 3. Information regarding the Student Exchange Program will be sent to the contact information that you write on Application form.
- 4. Press the "SUBMIT" button to submit the Application, and then check the status of your submission on EDIT.



### B. Required Documents

- 1) Completed Application Form
- 2) A Certificate of Enrollment from Currently Enrolled University (Korean or English)
- 3) A Letter of Recommendation from an Academic Source(Korean or English)
- 4) A Copy of the Passport Information Page
- 5) Original Sealed Transcript from Currently Enrolled University (Korean or English)
- 6) Certificate of Language Proficiency(Korean or English)<Optional>
- 7) X-Ray Tuberculosis(TB) Test Result
  - The result must be issued after July 1, 2019.
  - Please, send a digital copy of result to the coordinator via email by August 16, 2019
  - If applicants do not submit the result by August 16, 2019, the admission would be cancelled.
- \* Any documents in a language other than Korean or English must be accompanied by a Korean or English translation.

### Visa

- $\square$  We will send you the Certificate of Admission and Chonbuk National University's business registration  $\Rightarrow$  You must visit the Korean Embassy in your country with other **documents**\* required for visa issuing and apply for a Student Visa(D-2)
  - \* Please, check out the website of the Korean Consulate in your country.
  - \*\* We will fill the Alien Registration Form out while doing the Orientation.

### Dormitory

#### A. Chambit building

- 1) Fee: Approximately 1,000,000 KRW per semester
- 2) Meals: Provide three meals a day in dormitory cafeteria except all weekends. It is not allowed to cook at dormitory.
- 3) Facilities
  - Two persons in a room
  - Each room is furnished with a desk, a chair, an air conditioner, a bed, a wardrobe, and bathroom.



- B. Dormitory fees must be transferred to a dormitory account at Chonbuk National University before you arrive at Korea.
  - After you transfer the dormitory fee, the applicant's English name will be written on the receipt. Please, scan or copy the receipt and send it to the coordinator via email.
  - Specific details about the payment dates and account information will be notified via email.
- C. Dormitory fees include water and electricity.

## 6 Ins

### Insurance

- A. Insurance fee: 110,000 KRW/year, 60,000 KRW/six months
- B. Insurance Covers
  - Regular treatment, medicine, surgery, and hospitalization at a hospital
  - Dental and a cosmetic procedure are not covered by insurance
  - Accident caused by driving a car or motorcycle are not covered by insurance
- C. Students MUST get an insurance that CBNU recommends even though you purchase an insurance in your country.
