In late 19<sup>th</sup> c. a silver chalice was found in the Ilori church of St. George. The chalice stem, similar to the case of the Bedia chalice, is articulated by eight arched segments with figures placed on each. An image of the Enthroned Saviour with His right hand upraised in blessing and holding an open Gospel in His left hand is represented in the central arch. The Saviour is flanked by the images of the venerating Archangels Michael and Gabriel represented in the side arches, holding a chalice and a discos in their hands.

The front side of the chalice stem bears a one-line Georgian *asomtavruli* inscription with the supplication to the Saviour.

At present the whereabouts of the chalice are uncertain.
