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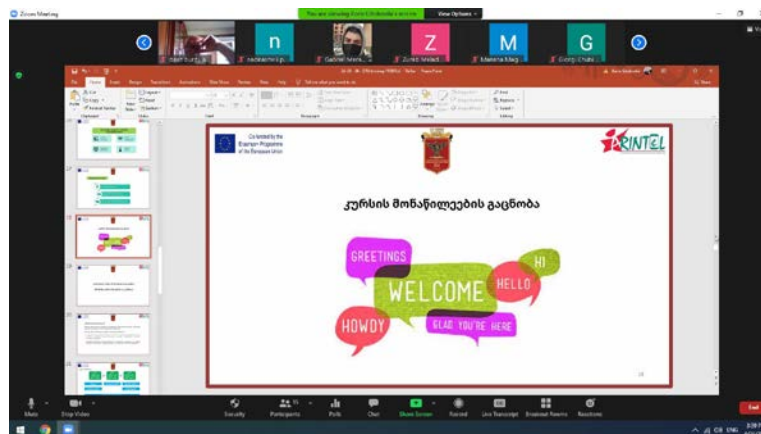

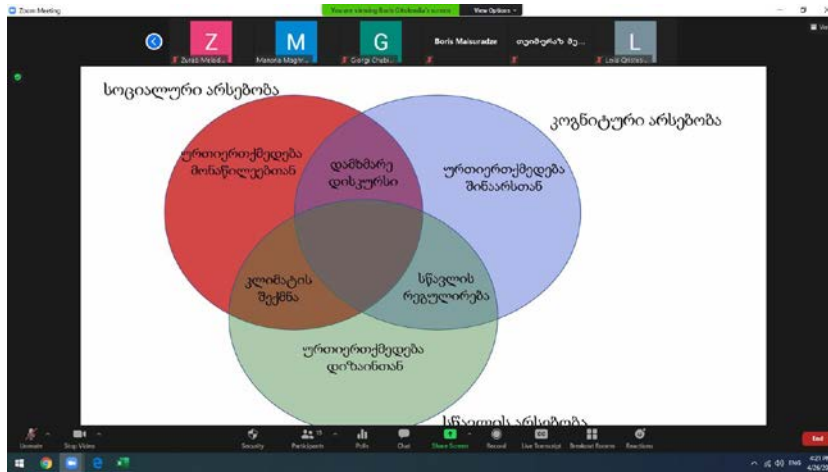

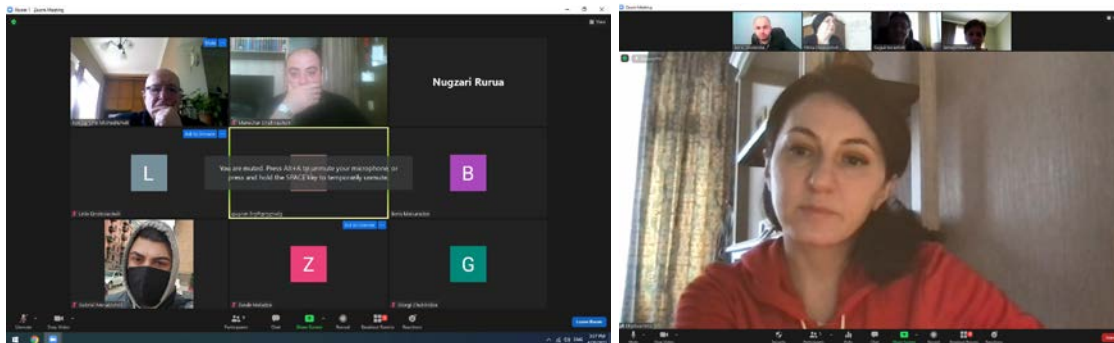
Preparation for the trainings

The course was led by Associate Professor Manuchar Shishinashvili (Faculty of Civil Engineering), who on his side completed ToT course under the PRINTeL project at Linköping University (Sweden). The trainings lasted 3 days, each one with 3 hour-long sessions. 9 sufficiently overloaded and intensive working hours included different activities like sessions and lectures; practical and group workshops; team and individual work and presentations. At the training were introduced the Community of Inquiry framework.



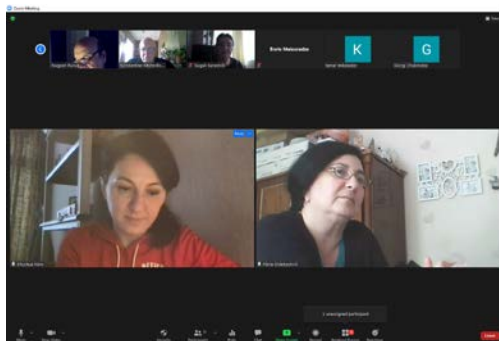
“About IT - „ the Community of Inquiry framework“ - “About Cognitive Presence””

Discussions were focused on Cognitive Presence; Social Presence; Emotional Presence.

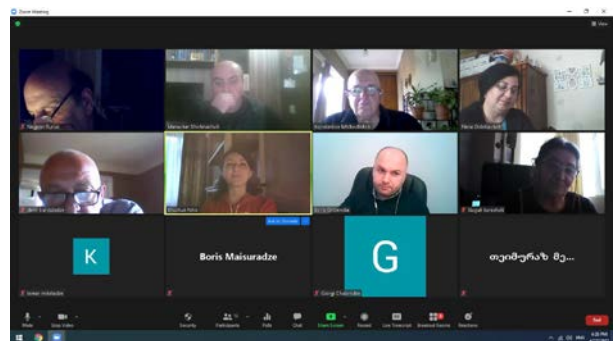


Group Works

The training course was entirely based on the experience of Linköping University and other international partners, also on personal experience.

The training was attended by 11 Professors of different Faculties of University: Faculty of Civil Engineering – 8 Professors, Faculty of Engineering Economic, Media Technology and Social Sciences – 1 Professor and Faculty of Business Technology – 2 Professors.
