

GTU – Training of Trainers on “Innovations and Entrepreneurial Programs in Higher Education Institutions”

To encourage entrepreneurial courses in GTU educational program and for improving the professional development of university’s staff, on 19-21 November, 2019, at GTU was held a certificated Training of Trainers (ToT) on “Innovations and Entrepreneurship Programs in Higher Educational Institutions” within the framework of the Georgian-British project “Creative Spark: Entrepreneurial Education Program for Higher Education”.

Internationally experienced British experts from the University of Keel (UK) led the training. Three days training included intensive different theoretical and practical activities, such as presentations, individual and group works, training-games and other practical sessions.



Within the framework of the project, with the moderation of British colleagues in the format of documental project, was prepared a syllabus course-project on “entrepreneurship” and a one-year activity plan of the GTU Innovations Center.

The training brought together a group of motivated people-coordinators. “Coordination group” will be actively involved in the future projects of GTU Innovations Center and will coordinate different events under the auspices of Creative Spark project.

It should be noted, that Georgian Technical University, as a partner university, in a collaboration with Keele University, is participating in the 2nd year project of “Creative Spark: Innovations and Entrepreneurial Programs in Higher Education Institutions”, which is funded by the British Council.



The project is being implemented by GTU International Relations and Standards Office, the project is in coordination with GTU’s Commercialization Department. At GTU project partners are the GTU Student Self-Government and the Department of Social Affairs, Sports and Culture. The project is organized by GTU Innovations Center.
