On March 7–11, 2022 Assoc. Prof. Catherine Abzianidze from GTU Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems participated in the International Week 2022 conducted at Kauno Kolegija / University of Applied Sciences - KUAS (Kaunas, Lithuania) within the Erasmus+ mobility project for teaching activities coordinated by KUAS.

Canceled last year due to a pandemic, this year Kauno Kolegija at the International Week welcomed guests from Georgia, Austria, Poland, Mexico, Latvia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Belgium, France, Spain, South Africa, Turkey, Slovakia, Portugal, etc. (from 40 countries) in Kaunas.



Teaching activities consisted of 8-hour course in Digital Communications, information theory and channel coding. The course was delivered for bachelor's and Master's students studying at KUAS Faculty of Technology.

Assoc. Prof. Catherine Abzianidze made a presentation introducing Georgian Technical University, her teaching activities and shared her experience in the field of channel coding research.

Young Georgian colleague was hosted by Prof. Giedrius Gecevičius, the Dean of Faculty of Technology; Ms. Victoria Gudauskaite, Erasmus+ Coordinator and academic staff of the Faculty. At the meeting were discussed the possibilities of joint research projects between the Faculties.
