Thanks to the collaboration agreed by the universities, up to 2 students, 1 academic and 1 administrative staff from Georgian University will be able to do an exchange during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2019-2020 academic year at the University of Beira Interior - UBI (Covilhã, Portugal).

The selected students will benefit from the following grant: 800 euro per month for up to five months and travels costs.

The selected academic staff will benefit from the following grant: 120 euro per day up to 5 days and travel costs.
