## David Bostanashvili Erasmus+ academic mobility report

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ academic mobility program, David Bostanashvili, associate professor of the Faculty of Urbanism and Design of STU Architecture, carried out academic activities in the period of March 28 - April 1, 2022, together with the Department of Architecture and Town Planning of the University of Malta, prof. Featuring Lino Bianco.

Within the mobility assoc. Prof. Davit Bostanashvili:

- Conducted three lectures on the poetics of architecture.
- Attended seminar presentations (with Prof. Lino Bianco).
- Participated in academic consultations (with Prof. Lino Bianco)

The subject "Poetics of Architecture" was created at the Technical University of Georgia by Prof. Shota Bostanashvili's original teaching method. The subject of architectural poetics has repeatedly received attention in the international arena. Since 2015, cooperation with the Faculty of Built Environment of the University of Malta is actively underway. Lino Bianco, professor of the faculty, has published a number of articles in the highest ranking international scientific journals where the philosophy and philosophy of architectural poetics are analyzed.

By means of this mobility, an important step in the process of internationalization of the Faculty of Architecture, Urbanism and Design has been made. An academic visit from the University of Mali as well as another cycle of lectures from GTU to the University of Malta is planned within the framework of the Erasmus Water Program in order to deepen the scientific-research and academic activities of the poetics of architecture.

The topics of the lectures held at the University of Malta were about the origins, history and method of the subject. Third year students attended the lectures.

At the seminar presentations of the students of the University of Malta, the topic of which includes the analysis and presentation of the thinking of important architects, the Maltese students presented two reports on the Manifesto of the Poetics of Architecture (Shota Bostanashvili, 1990) and the Manifesto of the Building (Shota Bostanashvili, Davit Bostanashvili, 2011). As a result of the collaboration between Malta and GTU, the subject of architecture poetics becomes part of the international academic discourse.
