



Within the host of Business Technologies Faculty in Georgian Technical University was held “Entrepreneur’s Day”

Within the framework of “Creative Spark: Entrepreneurial Education Program for Higher Education” 2nd year project, with the organization of GTU’s Innovation Center, on December 25th ,2019, in Georgian Technical University, for the second time, was held “GTU Entrepreneur’s Day”.
