

GTU Professor's lectures at the University of West Attica

On June 24-28 Prof. Paata Kervalishvili from Engineering Physics Department (GTU Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems) conducted lectures at the University of West Attica (Greece) within Erasmus+ mobility project for teaching activities, coordinated by UNIWA, which is one of the country's largest educational institution.

Prof. Kervalishvili delivered the cycle of lectures to UNIWA's Greek students (all three level: BA, MA, PhD), foreign postgraduate students (from universities of USA, the Czech Republic, Ukraine) and Greek colleagues from various departments of the University. The course of lectures was related to the methods and systems of quantum information technology and their application.

During the working meeting with Greek colleagues it was discussed the details about the new joint project within Erasmus+ programme. The project is aimed at further development and implementation of physical methods of detection and restoration of arts in various designs (including artefacts). The project proposal will be prepared by Georgian, Greek and Italian partners.
