Within the framework of this mobility both Georgian and Portuguese colleagues were working on the upgrading of University network services and enhance availability with pan-European GÉANT network, which is a fundamental element of Europe's e-infrastructure, delivering the <u>pan-European GÉANT network</u> for scientific excellence, research, education and innovation.
