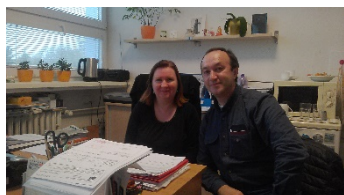


GTU Representatives Erasmus+ Training Mobility at Constantine the Philosopher University (CPU) in Nitra
