STT Mobility of GTU Grants Office Representative at Instituto Politécnico de Beja

Within the framework of the EU Erasmus+ Mobility (KA107) project, for the purpose of training activities, Luka Kemoklidze, a member of the Grants Office, a structural unit within the International Relations Department of the Georgian Technical University, visited project coordinator Instituto Politécnico de Beja on October 18-22, 2021.

During the mobility period, a GTU representative participated in Staff Week, giving a presentation on the University's history, capabilities and experiences. Participants also attended presentations by representatives of the Beja Polytechnic Institute and other participating universities. Activities during the staff week also included visits to the host institute's laboratories and business incubator.

During the mobility, meetings were held at the Department of International Affairs and Erasmus + offices, where issues related to new programs were discussed, including the prospects of joint cooperation in various EU programs. The parties talked about Georgia in general and the Georgian Technical University, the challenges in the conditions of the pandemic and the current educational and scientific activities in these conditions.

It is noteworthy that the rather busy work program of mobility also included cultural-cognitive events organized by the University of Beja. During the mobility period in Portugal, participants were given the opportunity to take part in a city tour and an official, traditional dinner.
